A kettle, along with tea, coffee and milk is provided in your room. You can drink the water from the taps, glasses are provided.

### Take-aways

We would prefer it if food was not delivered to the house. We have an excellent chef. Pre-booked food and snacks can be provided from our menu throughout the day.

#### The Gardens

If you would like to take advantage of the beautiful gardens, then please feel free. There are seating areas dotted around the grounds and in the wooded area around the pond (for your safety, please stay away from the edges of the pond). There are blankets to keep off the chill and chair coverings available. If you are settling in for a while with a good book, then you can request for the fire in your sitting area to be lit. Snacks and drinks can also be served to you outside.

### The Swimming Pool

We have a small swimming pool and sauna. Guests are permitted to use these. The pool is to be used at the guests own risk and children under 16 must be accompanied at all times. The sauna is for adult use only. The pool is open from 7am – 8pm. It is an air heated pool.
